"Itinerary"

May 15—Maine—Los Angeles

Today you will begin your great adventure. You will board your flight to Los Angeles and upon arrival transfer to hotel where you will meet your Tour Director to have any questions answered. Evening free to enjoy the city and have dinner on your own.

May 16—Los Angeles

Begin the day with a sightseeing tour of Los Angeles. Drive through Hollywood and see the historic Chinese Theater, Kodak Theater (home of the Academy Awards), see the Walk of Fame and the Street-air Farmers Market with its 140 shops and restaurants. The remainder of the day is on your own.

May 17—Los Angeles—Palm Springs

Journey to the desert oasis of Palm Springs home to ranch-style estates and elite hotels. Breathe in the clean, dry air and enjoy the sunshine with an afternoon and evening at leisure.

May 18—Palm Springs—Scottsdale

Today you will travel through the cacti-covered desert toward Old Town Scottsdale. Upon arrival you will check into the hotel and enjoy free time to explore this taste of the Old West.

May 19—Scottsdale—Sedona

Grand Canyon National Park and Williams

First stop today is a visit to Sedona. Climb through Oak Creek Canyon with its weather-sculpted formations and then pass by the San Francisco Mountains on your way to the South Rim of the Grand Canyon. While at the Canyon enjoy some time to stroll the rim, or take an optional helicopter flightseeing tour. Tonight you will overnight in Williams, a mountain town with Route 66 as the Main St and the gateway to the Grand Canyon.

May 20—Williams—Las Vegas

Cross the Mojave gold-strike country. Watch for Joshua trees which are known to grow to 40 feet in height and can live up to 300 years. By late afternoon you will reach Las Vegas for your two night stay.

Upon arrival you will enjoy an orientation tour along the colorful "Strip". Once you are checked in to your hotel you will enjoy the rest of the day at leisure.



May 21—Las Vegas

Free day to swim, sunbathe at the hotel pool, visit one or more casinos, shop or take in a show or two. Your Tour Director will also have more suggestions and will be there to help you decide how to spend your day.

May 22—Las Vegas—Tulare
